4. If you wear contact lenses, bring necessary solutions and a pair of glasses.
5. All flashes and name tapes required by NSCC Uniforms Regulations must be on outer garmets except raincoats. All items must be marked with cadet's name and last 4 digits of SSN on manufacturer's label or inside waistband.
6. Do not bring candy, gum, weapons, or expensive items. Personal communications devices must be surrendered upon check in and will be returned at check out.
7. Cadets will be required to obtain certain pieces of personal dive equipment (mask, snorkel mouthpieces, etc) for hygiene and safety reasons. These will be available for purchase on the first day of training. MASKS AND FINS DESIGNED FOR SNORKELING ARE NOT SUITABLE FOR SCUBA.
